Homes and social gatherings with varying restrictions (but not lock-down).</p>	<p>Mandarin Service will livestream from Kingsgrove at 9am with a small, COVID-safe congregation in attendance.</p> <p>Kingsgrove 11am and Bankstown 4pm will not be opened for gathering as whole congregations.</p> <p>11am and 4pm services will be online and open to the public via Zoom.</p> <p>Small groups based around CGs (or a mixture of CGs) may gather in person in homes and public venues (based on current NSW Health limits), or on church premises in a COVID-safe way.</p> <p>Up to 100 may meet at Kingsgrove premises at any one time (this is subject to change at any time based on NSW Health regulations). Physical distancing, contact registering, and cleaning protocols will be observed. Congregational singing is not allowed.</p>	<p>CGs will continue meeting in person and online.</p> <p>CG's can meet together in a home for food, fellowship, Bible study and prayer in small groups of up to 20 (numbers subject to change by NSW Health). Group leaders must ensure these gatherings are also conducted in a COVID-safe way.</p> <p>Up to 100 may meet on church premises at Kingsgrove at any one time (this is subject to change at any time based on NSW Health regulations). Physical distancing, contact registering, and cleaning protocols will be observed.</p>	<p>Youth group is able to meet in person on church premises or in homes under COVID-safe protocols. It is at the discretion of the youth leadership when face-to-face meetings resume or when they stay or return online.</p> <p>Youth under 18 do not need to follow strict physical distancing guidelines, however leaders must maintain 1.5m distancing where practical.
